The first reason is that it is the largest country, in terms of arable land^[1], but more significantly due to its continued commitment to diversifying its agricultural capabilities and implementing governmental policies that incentivize agricultural business investment. For example, in only two short years, Brazil saw a momentous increase in the size of its exported agricultural cargos - expanding from a total of 150 million metric tons (MMT) in 2021 to 216 MMT in 2023. These exported cargos include soybeans, maize, sugar, and other Agri-products.



Enhancing our Analytical Capabilities

For over 85 years, we have supported the agricultural industry in Brazil. During this time, we have expanded our network and now operate sixteen branches, including five cutting-edge laboratories. Four of the facilities are fully dedicated to conducting trade inspections, ensuring that the local Agri-products meet the highest standards for quality and safety.

In 2023, we unveiled our fifth laboratory in São Bernardo do Campo, within the lively metropolitan region of São Paulo. This newest laboratory provides a full scope of testing services, including microbiology, nutritional analysis, and testing for pesticides and heavy metals, an essential service in the modern agricultural and food industries. Across each lab, we have achieved a plethora of accreditations and certifications, including ISO 17025, AOAC, GMP+, SAL, and MAPA (Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Supply).

We are also boast Gafta-approved Superintendent & Analyst status, and FOSFA-approved analysts for oilseeds, oils, and fat.

In terms of our analytical capabilities, collectively, we can perform over 102,000 different scopes of analysis, including for the likes of genetically modified organisms (GMOs), mycotoxins, and heavy metals.

Meanwhile, our inspectors and surveyors perform over 360,000 inspections on agri-loaded cargo in the same time frame, protecting the safety, integrity, and quality of commodities.

These commendable figures, alongside our recognitions and memberships, bear testimony to the crucial role we play as the incomparable, onestop shop for Brazil's agricultural testing, inspection, and certification needs.

Plans for our facilities include broadening the range of services offered. Most notably, our Rio Grande laboratory endeavors to introduce wheat analysis capabilities, enhancing its portfolio and further aiding in the thorough analysis of Brazilian agricultural commodities.
