

SGS Halal Certificate and Schedule of Certification (SOC) License to use National Halal Mark (issued by MoIAT) Halal Certified Companies in UAE and outside of UAE can apply to MoIAT for the license to use the National Halal Mark. They can apply online using MoIAT website and by uploading the below documents: Technical reports (evaluation report, onsite assessment report and test report) LICENSE FOR HALAL NATIONAL MARK Valid accreditation certificate with the scope of accreditation from the accredited Halal Certification Bodies. The technical file will be reviewed by MoIAT and the decision to grant the National Halal Mark License will be done.
