PUWER

 To guarantee the safety and appropriate upkeep of the machinery and equipment employers must abide by the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations. Not only is (PUWER) compliance essential for the safety of your workers but it demonstrates the ethical risk management of business assets.

Applicability

- According to the Health and Safety at Work etc Act 1974, employers have a duty to maintain the safe operation and prevent deterioration of equipment as laid out in section 2(a): "the provision and maintenance of plant and systems of work that are, so far as is reasonably practicable, safe and without risks to health". To ensure conformity with the legislation an effective (PUWER) assessment will help employers demonstrate compliance. Everything from simple hand tools to complex, state-of-the-art machinery must comply with (PUWER).
- Both the supply and utilization of work equipment are covered under (PUWER). The term "use" refers to all potential uses.

Typical applications of PUWER for end users could be before first use of equipment, or for maintenance at suitable intervals to ensure subsequent deteriorate of equipment does not occur.

- · Prosecute employers or other accountable persons


