

CHARGES FOR E-INVOICING SERVICES

ON BEHALF OF CENTRAL BANK OF NIGERIA

February 1, 2022

SUPPLIER'S AUTHENTICATION

Verification of information uploaded by cross-border suppliers to or from the Federal Republic of Nigeria to the Enrolment Portal for the purpose of entity authentication by SGS on behalf of the Central Bank of Nigeria (CBN).

USD 350 (three hundred and fifty United States dollars) per authentication valid for one year.

E-INVOICE AUTHENTICATION

Authentication on behalf of CBN in respect of cross-border supplies made to or from the Federal Republic of Nigeria of invoices submitted to the e-Invoicing Platform by authenticated suppliers.

USD 6 (six United States dollars) per authentication.

Charges are payable in advance, upon application and submission of corresponding data by the Supplier and regardless of whether the assessment permits the authentication of the Supplier or e-invoice.

The above-mentioned charges payable by each Supplier are exclusive of VAT, sales tax, and any local tax applicable in the country of the Supplier. Charges and any applicable taxes shall be remitted by the Suppliers to SGS with a bank account designated by SGS.

The provision of e-Invoicing services is subject to the full "Terms and Conditions for e-Invoicing Services" published on the same website.
