LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, learners will be able to:

- Explain the purpose and business benefits of an ISMS, of information security management system standards, management system audit and third-party certification.
- Explain the role of an Auditor to plan, conduct, report and follow-up an audit of an ISMS to establish conformity or otherwise with ISO/IEC 27001:2022 (with ISO/IEC 27002:2022) in accordance with ISO 19011 and ISO/IEC 17021, where appropriate.

AUDIENCE

This course is designed for:

- Learners who wish to transfer their existing auditing skills from other management systems to those needed for ISMS.

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COURSE AIM

The aim of the course is to provide learners with the knowledge and skills required to perform first, second and third-party audits of information security management systems (ISMS) against ISO/IEC 27001:2022, in accordance with ISO 19011 and ISO/IEC 17021, as appropriate.

PRIOR KNOWLEDGE

Before starting the course, learners are expected to have prior knowledge of the following principles and concepts:

- Management systems.
- Understanding of the Plan-Do-Check-Act (PDCA) cycle.
- Information security management.
- Knowledge of the following information security management principles:
 - Awareness of the need for information security.
 - The assignment of responsibility for information security.
 - Incorporating management commitment and the interests of stakeholders.
 - Enhancing societal values.
 - Using the results of risk assessments to determine appropriate controls to reach acceptable levels of risk.
 - Incorporating security as an essential element of information networks and systems.
 - The active prevention and detection of information security incidents.
 - Ensuring a comprehensive approach to information security management.
 - Continual reassessment of information security and making of modifications as appropriate.
- Knowledge of the requirements of ISO/IEC 27001 (with ISO/IEC 27001) and the commonly used information security management terms and definitions, as given in ISO/IEC 27000 (overview and vocabulary), which may be gained by completing a CQI and IRCA certified ISMS Foundation Training Course or equivalent.
- Learners for this conversion course should have completed a full 5-day IRCA certified Auditor/Lead Auditor course in another scheme prior to attending the course. This is a pre-requisite requirement to register on the CQI and IRCA Auditor certification scheme.

- The purpose of an information security management system and the business benefits of improving information security performance
- The role of the ISMS Auditor
- Planning and conducting the audit
- Generating audit findings
- Reporting and audit follow-up

COURSE CERTIFICATION

On completion of this course:

- Learners who pass both the examination and continuous assessment will be issued with a “Certificate of Achievement” that satisfies the formal training for an individual seeking certification as a CQI and IRCA Auditor. The “Certificate of Achievement” is valid for a period of five years from the date of the last day of the examination for certifying as an Auditor with the CQI and IRCA.
- Learners who do not pass the continuous assessment and have been in attendance for the full duration of the course will be issued with a “Certificate of Attendance”.
- Learners who fail the written examination and pass the continuous assessment will receive a “Certificate of Attendance” and will be allowed to re-sit the examination within 12 months of the end date of the original course.
